Turbine Hunt on Sliabh Bá

Sliabh Bán Wind Fest kicks off on Easter Sunday during the Strokestown Easter Parade. Children will be handed out the 'Turbine Test', which will be a simple quiz where they will have to figure out which is the tallest of four objects, one of which will be a wind turbine.

On Easter Monday at 2 pm everybody will be invited to meet at the Sliabh Bán quarry car park near Frank's Pub, Ballybeg, to be handed a balloon and the 'Wind Fest Wind Test' will begin. We have decided to only release one large balloon because of environmental concerns and this will be retrieved afterwards. Then everybody will be given a map and walk around the mountain to search for the sites where Coillte is proposing wind turbines are to be built. This is the 'Turbine Hunt' and people will be looking for model turbines placed to indicate where the turbines are likely to be. On each model turbine will be written a word. When people have found the individual words written on each of the twenty-one turbines they can return to Frank's Pub to put the words together and form a well-known phrase.

Then there will be a draw from all the correct entries in the 'Turbine Test' and the child drawn will win a prize. After this another draw will occur from all the correct entries from the 'Turbine Hunt' for a person to receive another prize. This will be followed by a spring barbecue, and hopefully a little bit of mountain music!

This festival is for everybody and all are welcome. If you don't want to do the Turbine Hunt you are welcome to walk a few minutes to the picnic area for a cup of tea and then return to your car. We hope to see a large crowd enjoying Sliabh Bán mountain on the day.
