Naughten critical of Harristown House delay

A decision regarding an alternative use for Harristown House in Castlerea has still not been made, according to Denis Naughten TD this week.

"Eight months after the Minister for Justice confirmed that Harristown House would not re-open as a residential treatment facility, despite previous assurances to the contrary, there is still no decision regarding an alternative use for the facility," stated Denis Naughten.

"Just this week the Minister has confirmed that his Department is still in

consultation with the Irish Prison Service regarding what potential alternative use might be made of the facility.

"We have already seen the Minister back-track completely on his commitment that the facility would re-open and now we are faced with a situation where he is stalling in making a decision about any possible alternative use of the premises. The Minister is now running the risk of losing the skill set and knowledge built up over the past ten years in the staffing pool of Harristown House."

Doherty queries progress on Kilronan Cemetery

Cllr. Rachel Doherty this week asked Roscommon County Council to provide a progress report on the ongoing negotiations in relation to an extension to Kilronan Cemetery.

"The current situation is of huge concern to the local community and it should be brought to a satisfactory conclusion as a matter of urgency," said Cllr. Doherty. The response by the Director was that most recent contact with the landowner on this matter was on May 19th and that further discussions will take place in three weeks' time.

Cllr. Doherty stressed the urgency in getting closure on these ongoing negotiations and requested that the matter be brought to conclusion within the next month as it has dragged on for far too long. Cllr. Doherty concluded by saying that people want to see a satisfactory outcome to these discussions.
