Took money from behind bar counter

Cocaine, cannabis seized in Good Friday searches in Castlerea

Quantities of cocaine and cannabis were seized in the Castlerea area following a number of separate searches on Good Friday afternoon last.

Gardaí carried out a search of a house in the Cashel Park estate, Castlerea, on a warrant under the Misuse of Drugs Act.

A quantity of cannabis resin was seized and a person is due to appear in court in relation to the matter at a later stage.

On the same afternoon, at approximately 2 pm, a car was stopped at a filling station in the town and searched under the Misuse of Drugs Act. €250 worth of canna-

bis herb was found underneath the bonnet.

A follow-up search by Gardaí in a house in Ballinagare found approximately €250 worth of cocaine and €300 worth of cannabis herb. Drug paraphernalia was also seized.

Pub burgled

Gardaí in Roscommon are investigating a burglary at a licensed premises in Roscommon town, which occurred between Friday evening and Saturday morning last, April 2nd and 3rd. A small amount of alcohol was taken.

Pepper spray used in Ballaghaderreen

In the early hours of Monday morning last, Garda gave chase to a car that was observed driving down a one-way street in Ballaghaderreen and which failed to stop for Gardaí.

The driver jumped out of the car outside a private house outside the town and proceeded to cause damage to the house. He was in possession of an implement and when the Gardaí arrived he refused to drop the implement and Gardaí used pepper spray, which caused the man to leave the implement down and comply with Gardaí. He was arrested and is due to appear at a forthcoming sitting of the local district court.
