two heads, two tails, six legs and two bodies.

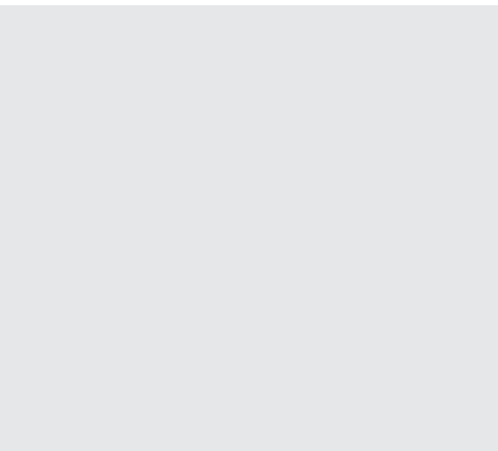
Was it Halley's Comet?

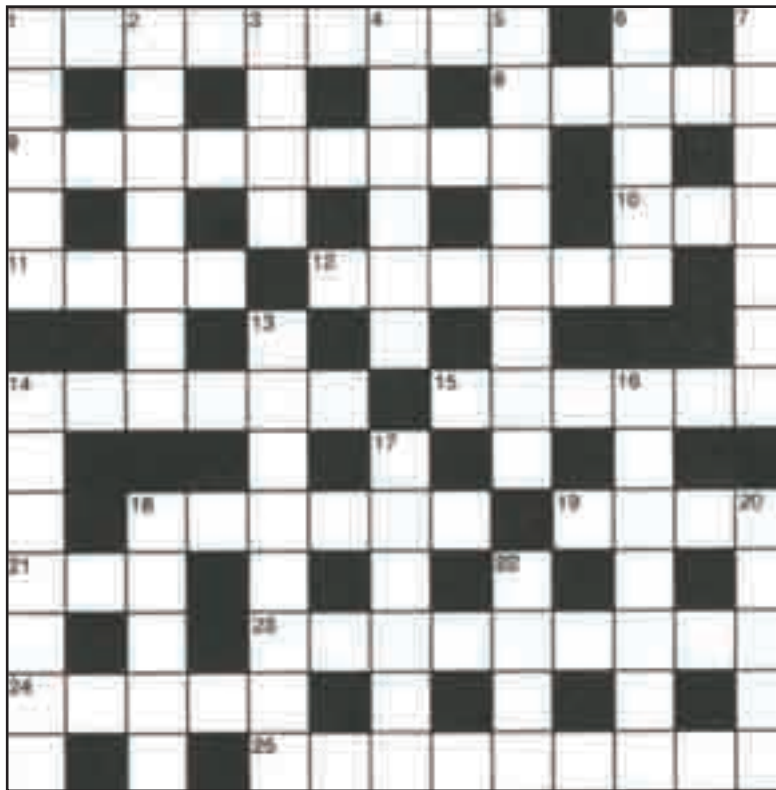


SUDOKU
