

Finneran invited to next hospital meeting

Roscommon Hospital Action Committee has written to both Minister Michael Finneran TD and Mr. John Hennessy, Interim Director of Operations, HSE West, inviting them to a further public meeting on the issue of the future of Roscommon County Hospital.

Following the public meeting on threats to the future of services at the Hospital on Thursday, June 3rd last, the Hospital Action Committee was instructed by those attending to organise another public meeting within the next month and to invite both Minister Michael Finneran TD and Mr. John Hennessy, Interim Director of Operations, HSE West.

Minister Finneran was written to this week to invite him to attend on a date that suited him. Both he and Mr. Hennessy

had been invited to the previous meeting on June 3rd last also. This meeting will enable clarification of the position with regard to services at Roscommon Hospital.

"The Hospital Action Committee has been inundated with calls and messages about the services at the hospital since the meeting and the sense among people is that they are nervous and angry about any threats to services. People are fearful for themselves and their families about travelling longer distances for services, especially acute services where the 'Golden Hour' is so important.

"We heard at the meeting from people about their various experiences at Roscommon County Hospital from life-saving emergencies to routine clinical services. But the underlying

sentiment of people is that they want to be able to access acute and day to day services at their own hospital in Roscommon and they do not want to be sent to Galway where overcrowding, lack of car parking and queues are issues.

"A super-manager at UCHG to manager UCHG, Portlucula and Roscommon Hospitals has been appointed. People fear this manager will make decisions for Roscommon Hospital who will then not be able to respond to local needs. The first job of the new manager at UCHG will be to reduce the €30 million deficit at UCHG. This deficit should not be plugged at the expense of services in Roscommon. Services at Roscommon should not be pulled to save money that will go towards reducing this debt."
