- Courses will be run subject to sufficient enrolment and prior payment.
- Place will be allocated on a first come first served basis and are prioritised for childcare practitioners working in the sector in County Roscommon.

RCCC Training & Events Fee Payment & Cancellation Policy

As of 1st July 2009, payment for all events organised by Roscommon County Childcare Committee (RCCC) must be made PRIOR to the event. Registration will not be complete until payment has been made in full and this means that you will NOT be guaranteed entrance/a place on course/training if you have only registered but have not made the payment.

The cost of venues and the time of presenters are key factors in determining effective events and/or training and, by taking this action, it is hoped that RCCC will be able to continue to deliver stimulating and exciting events/training in the years to come.

Cancellations must be submitted in writing by mail, fax or e-mail to RCCC. It is RCCC's policy to charge full price for all cancellations made within 24 hours of the event and for all no-shows. However, if payment has been made in full, cancellation may be possible if it is made in writing 4 weeks prior to commencement of the course. RCCC will refund fees if cancellations occur on our side but are not liable for any expenses incurred by the participant associated with joining the course/event/training.
