Oran Mast opposition group hold fundraiser in Cuisle this weekend

The Oran/Donamon Action Group are holding a major community awareness fund-raising function in the Cuisle Centre this Friday night, 21st May, to raise funds for their campaign against proposals by eircom to locate a telecommunications mast in the Oran/Donamon area.

John F. Hanley of the action group says that their campaign is gathering pace and that Friday night's fund-raising event will be a major part of the campaign so far.

"The situation at the moment is that work has ceased on the site. We had arranged a meeting between ourselves, the IFA, and eircom last Tuesday but eircom pulled out of that and we await the court hearing now on the 15th of June.

"There are a number of issues that we have with the proposed mast but the most important issue is that it will be built within 30 metres of a residence with children and that's unacceptable. We cannot understand why An Bord Pleanála have over-ruled Roscommon County Council on this one."

"We have a big night planned for Friday night. We have music with the popular Vinegar Bill and we have a major auction on the night. We have received great support and local businesses have been very supportive. We are expecting a huge crowd because the local community is totally behind this campaign," he concluded.

The fund-raising night will be held at the Cuisle Centre, Donamon and will start at 9.30 pm. All are welcome.

Funding for community and Voluntary Fora

Voluntary Fora in counties Roscommon and Leitrim are to receive €48,148 as part of a 1.175 million package, it was announced by the Minister for Housing and Local Services, Michael Finneran, this week.

€26,479 is being allocated to Roscommon County Council and

€21,699 to Leitrim County Council for supporting the work of the Community and Voluntary Fora in both counties.

The announcement is part of an expenditure package of €1.175 million to support the work of local community and voluntary fora across the country and their national

representative body, the Irish National Community and Voluntary Forum in 2010. The local fora were established in each of the 34 County and City Councils in 2000, as part of a Government commitment to promote partnership between the State and community and voluntary sector at local level.

Roscommon County Council hereby gives notice that the under mentioned road will be closed to public traffic from Monday 31st May 2010 until Monday 28th June 2010 to facilitate the laying of water mains on the Clooneygrasson Group Water Scheme.

L1630-30 (Slieve and Corbally 3 roads to Leamore) from its junction with L-66292-0 at Slieve and Corbally to L1630-61 at Leamore.

Alternative Westbound Route from L1630-30 to L1630-61 at Leamore.

Take L66292 from Emlaghglasny junction with Slieve and Corbally to N60 at Bellacagher and then N60 to junction with L1634-0 at Cloonagrassan.

Alternative Eastbound Route from L-1630-61 at Leamore to L1630-30 at Slieve and Corbally.

The above route in reverse order.

Emergency and local access will be provided. Diversions will be signposted.
