As each representative accepted their cheque they explained what the money would be used for in their organisation. Chairperson Bina Harris sincerely thanked everyone who took part in the walk. She pointed out that it was a particularly difficult year as the unusually harsh weather conditions in December meant that the original event was postponed from St. Stephen's day until St. Valentine's Day. In spite

of this and of the fact that we are in very difficult times financially, the occasion was extremely well supported and the generosity of people was outstanding.

Michael O'Roarke thanked everyone for their continued support and for attending on the night. He announced that the grand total of €21,000 was collected and reiterated that given the circumstances this year it as a great tribute to the generosity of the community. Music was provided by the very popular Hugh Collins.
