Other events taking place will be a bi-lingual quiz at the Lir Café bar on Tuesday, 30th March and a singers seisuin on Wednesday, 31st March in Solans Bar. There will be a Comhaltas seisuin at Spells bar on Thursday, April 3rd and there will be other sessions in bars throughout the town.
