Unholy row over Council prayer

There was a controversial start to the July meeting of Roscommon County Council when the new Mayor of the council Cllr Luke Ming Flanagan declined to say the prayer, which is recited prior to the start of every meeting.

Cllr Flanagan said that he was an agnostic and he said he would not be a hypocrite and say something that he did not believe in. He asked the meetings administrator Fiona Quinn to recite the prayer instead.

However Cllr Flanagan's course of action angered Independent Cllr Tom Crosby who said that Cllr Flanagan should step down from the chair and allow the deputy mayor to say the prayer instead. Cllr Crosby said that it had been a tradition in the council for 111 years to say the prayer.

However Cllr Valerie Byrne and Cllr Sean Beirne backed Cllr Flanagan stating that the mayor did not object to the prayer being said and that it had been recited as usual. "It's a disgrace that the first citizen of the county didn't say the prayer," said Cllr Crosby to which Cllr Flanagan replied, "You have got what you wanted Cllr Crosby, badly needed publicity because people were forgetting who you were."

FF Cllr John Cummins then suggested that the meeting adjourn for three to four minutes to come up with a solution and when the councillors returned it was agreed that for all future county council meetings that the vice mayor Cllr Ernie Keenan would recite the prayer.

"I'm glad that's settled now," said Cllr Flanagan, "there is nothing worse than people saying things they don't mean. I despise that," he concluded.

Connaughton's RISE! Campaign motion backed by Council

A notice of motion from Cllr. Martin Connaughton calling on the Council and the Government to listen to the concerns being expressed by the RISE! Campaign was passed unanimously at last Monday's meeting of Roscommon County Council. Cllr. Connaughton's notice read, "That Roscommon County Council call on the Government to listen to the concerns being expressed by the RISE! Campaign, which

shares the concerns it is highlighting over various items of legislation being promoted by the Minister for Environment, Heritage and Local Government, John Gormley TD. County Roscommon is a rural county and field sports play an important part of everyday life in rural communities."

Cllr Connaughton this week noted that Dr. Paddy Wall, speaking at the AGM of Roscommon Hunt held last week in

Regan's, stressed the need to retain countryside pursuits such as Roscommon Hunt. Cllr. Connaughton said, "We live in Roscommon, not in Dublin, where the Greens come from. Ireland is green and the land that people hunt on is green and we want to retain that."

The notice of motion was passed unanimously and will now be forward on to the Minister of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, John Gormley TD.

Local man killed in motorcycle accident

A young 23-year-old Roscommon man was killed when the motorcycle he was travelling on lost control and hit a signpost near the village of Knockananna in Co. Wicklow at Sunday at midday.

Owen McManus, who was living in Dublin but originally of Belrea, Drum, Athlone, Co. Roscommon, was travelling with a group of motorcyclists heading northwest away from Tinahely. He was driving his Suzuki bike around

a tight bend on the road when the fatal accident occurred.

The road is a popular one with motorcyclists heading out for weekend rides in the countryside.

His remains reposed at his residence yesterday with the removal taking place today, Thursday, to St. Bridget's Church, Drum, for Mass of the Resurrection at 4.30 pm with burial afterwards in Drum Cemetery.

Kenny welcomes road repairs in Moore

Local Independent Councillor Jimmy Kenny this week welcomed essential road repairs currently being carried out from Moore Community Hall to Rooty Cross.

It is expected further road repairs will be carried out in the Moore area over the coming months, including the Thomastown to Shannonbride road.
